

Australia commits \$14.1 million for COVID-19 vaccine access during 2020-23 in Solomon Islands:



SUPPLYING DOSES \$4.3 million

- ✓ 213,000 vaccines from Australia's own supply line
- ✓ COVID-19 vaccines procured through Australia's agreement with UNICEF



SUPPORTING NATIONAL VACCINE ROLL-OUT \$8.6 million

- ✓ Surge capacity and training for health workers
- ✓ Logistical support to vaccine roll-out
 - ✓ Cold chain equipment
- ✓ Communications campaigns to raise awareness and promote vaccination in the community



PROVIDING AUSTRALIAN EXPERTISE \$1.2 million

- ✓ Strengthening systems to ensure vaccine safety
- ✓ Using evidence to build quality immunisation programs
