

## Australia commits \$1.35 million for COVID-19 vaccine access during 2020-23 in Tuvalu:



### **SUPPLYING DOSES \$0.08 million**

- ✓ 7,000 vaccines from Australia's own supply line delivered to date
- ✓ COVID-19 vaccines to be procured through Australia's agreement with UNICEF



### **SUPPORTING NATIONAL VACCINE ROLL-OUT \$0.1 million**

- ✓ Communications campaigns to raise awareness and promote vaccination in the community
